It provides an open space to present and discuss projects, share and bridge resources, and reflect on ethical and humanly sustainable artistic practices.

Feedforward is a research and networking platform in which practitioners are invited to present their work, receiving and giving challenging feedback and genuine support one another.

The sessions can be online video-meetings (open or not to the public) or physical convival events, depending on the locations of the participants. Common to all sessions is a principle of equality and respect among the group and the desire to reach mutual understanding and seek opportunities for cooperation.

The **Feedforward** programme is developed by Looking Forward, a curatorial office based in London commissioning and producing transnational projects with specific focus on social justice.
